Community Grants Overview & Guidelines

What We Fund

Georgia Rehabilitation Institute has several funding priorities. Applications are welcome from 501(c)(3) organizations or government organizations that provide services and programs benefiting persons with disabilities.

Priorities Include

- Accessible affordable housing
- Accessible affordable transportation
- Employment of persons with disabilities
- Adaptive sports and leisure events, programs, and projects
- Medical Rehabilitative research
- Accessible cultural arts
- Adaptive technology
- Community accessibility improvements

What We Don't Fund

- Grants for individuals
- Deficit financing and debt retirement
- Political organizations or campaigns
- Lobbying legislators, legislation or influencing elections
- Business start-ups

Who May Apply

Georgia Rehabilitation Institute provides grants to 501(c)(3) tax exempt non-profit organizations and local governments. Our focus will be on organizations serving Richmond, Columbia, and Aiken counties.

Site Visit

Georgia Rehabilitation Institute leadership may request a site visit before determining an application approval or award.

Outcome Reporting

Georgia Rehabilitation Institute requires two (2) to four (4) measurable outcomes to be included in the applicant's application. A written report reviewing the outcomes and overall project success will be shared with Georgia Rehabilitation Institute at the completion of the funded project or at 6 months after the award receipt (whichever comes first).

Review and Award Process

Completed applications can be submitted (mailed) at any time from July 1st through April 30th. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Applicants will be notified of approval or denial in August after the April 30th application deadline.

Grant awards will be made over the next 12 month period following the August notification. The applicant can request a month for the grant award payment to meet project goals or will be determined by Georgia Rehabilitation Institute.

Applicants may apply for one grant per funding cycle.
